2.2 Startup environment for Vietnamese students

Attitudes and society have a direct influence on the entrepreneurial spirit and decision to start a business of the people and the entrepreneurial spirit of the youth and students. The legal policies of a country will directly affect the creation of a culture of

entrepreneurship and creativity. In fact, countries with a positive attitude and support for entrepreneurship will have a higher level of entrepreneurship and innovation. Because society has a positive perception of the role of the startup community and wants to have better policies for startup activities, it will directly affect the confidence of individuals when they want to start an activity. business movement. They will easily accept risks, overcome countless difficulties to implement their ideas to contribute and create new values for society.

3. Research results and discussion

Creative ability

According to a study by Amway Group in collaboration with Technische Universitat Munchen (TUM) and market research company Gesellschaft fuer Konsumforschung (GfK), Vietnam is the country with the highest entrepreneurial spirit in the world. 91% of Vietnamese surveyed said they view starting a new business as a desirable career opportunity. 95% have a positive attitude towards the spirit of entrepreneurship and ownership. This rate is higher than the world average, which stands at only 77%. Indeed, it's not too difficult for you to find a "startup" when you step foot in the alley. From coffee shops, technology applications to companies, trading businesses... All are startup projects of young people. Among them, many are students studying at the university. Some people even decide to stop studying to start a business.

Favorabilities

Students have the advantage of being young, not afraid of difficulties and ready to "do it again" if there is a failure. Students are not pressured by family or financial burdens, so it is easy to take risks. 4. Conclusions and recommendations

Therefore, there are now signs to overcome and recover. More than half a million businesses are active to promote the entrepreneurial spirit of students while at school, and hundreds of universities have invested in facilities for students to conduct start-ups. In addition, the state has not shown any positive signs for arousing the entrepreneurial spirit of Vietnamese students. It is necessary to pay more attention and form the entrepreneurial mindset

of students when the 4.0 era is near. According to statistics over the past 2 years from 2017 to 2017, there are more than 1665 projects to support students to start a business by 2025. And up to now, there are 300 projects with rich quality of ideas and invested in ASEAN countries. as well as students in your home country conducting start-ups. The majority of students today are still afraid of entrepreneurship and are prone to failure, that's why it is necessary to have bold ideas and withstand failure that deserve the attention and consideration of the state to let students succeed. employees trust and start more businesses. The project must focus on students' ideas.

Entrepreneurial spirit of ASEAN students

The government has a good support policy for students to start their own start-up sessions in ASEAN countries. standards to attract students to star-up sessions. The level of incentives and good projects for marine life when starting a business. Thereby, it shows that investing in startup students in ASEAN countries is necessary to identify environmental factors in more successful start-ups. According to statistics, there are 120-150 startup students in Singapore every year. With a support cost of up to 50,000 USD, it has created a safe environment for students to start a business. Thereby, the spirit of ASEAN students is higher than that of Vietnam. Therefore, let's have a positive impact on the environment of many countries to start a business more rationally and be more dynamic when the 4.0 era is near. Vietnamese students are not highly aware of the spirit of entrepreneurship like other countries in the region. They lack practical experience of learning in books and lack practical knowledge. Still indifferent in awareness in rural and remote areas, the quality of teaching as well as the quality of students has not been improved in the spirit of entrepreneurship right from the school chair. The rampant start-up is not too good for Vietnamese students, when there is no clear separation calculation, losses happen frequently among the youngest entrepreneurs, especially young Vietnamese.

Recommendations for Vietnamese students

On the basis of an overview of some results of law enforcement monitoring related to supporting start-ups in our country, the Ministry of Justice makes a number of proposals and recommendations to improve the quality and efficiency of operations. Support for start-ups is outlined as follows:

Firstly, it is necessary to review, synthesize, and propose the amendment, replacement or construction of new legal documents to both ensure consistency and synchronization in the system and effectively support enterprises. starting a business.

Second, Simplify and publicize administrative processes and procedures related to the organization and operation of enterprises at agencies and units as well as on the electronic portals of ministries, agencies and localities. promote the application of information technology in receiving and processing applications for startups.

Thirdly, Detect and replicate effective support models for start-ups, strengthen dialogue between start-ups and representatives of State agencies. Thereby, the two sides listen together, exchange and solve difficulties and problems.

Fourth, Enhancing the role of business associations and industry associations, promoting the role of a bridge

between State management agencies and enterprises. Performing well its role is an important channel for policy criticism on businesses, allowing the business community to monitor and evaluate the activities of government agencies as a basis for improving service quality. Timely and proactively receive and process information about reflecting on specific cases and "hot" issues in real-life social life in order to propose solutions and effective policy responses and respond to them. requirements for State management and protection of legitimate interests of enterprises.

Fifth, there is a connection and coordination between State agencies, representative organizations of enterprises and bar associations and bar unions to provide legal support in specific situations. Promote legal support for start-ups in many forms such as in writing, online, and by phone. In addition, it is necessary to propagate and disseminate the State's policies on supporting start-ups through conferences, seminars, and seminars on legal topics for start-ups to create favorable conditions. for businesses to access policies and legal information and raise awareness and sense of compliance with the law.

Sixth, for start-ups, it is necessary to prepare the necessary elements when starting a business. Actively research and update information on policies and laws to promptly catch, receive and take advantage of opportunities and incentives from policies and the State and minimize risks in the process of starting a business. Karma. In addition, strengthening linkages and cooperation between businesses, especially large domestic and foreign enterprises, to make the most of capital, human resources, as well as technology or markets.

Proposing national policy activists to start a business
